1 Samuel 1:17

Prayer—Petitioning God in Prayer

Ezekiel 22:30

Moses interceded for the nation of Israel when Israel rebelled, and God answered. Pick a country to pray for today and ask God to bring His salvation to people in that nation.

Numbers 14:13

Focus on praying for people in your government. Pray that God would place His hand on them and give them wisdom.

1 Timothy 2:1

Did you know that Jesus intercedes for us before God the Father? He was the one Who intervened on our behalf, and still does. Thank Jesus that He intercedes in heaven for you today—He loves you so much.

Hebrews 7:25

Did you know that the Holy Spirit intercedes for you when you don't know what to say? He is our great Helper! Thank the Holy Spirit for helping you today!

Romans 8:26-27

Prayer—Intercessory Prayer

Have you thanked God for His goodness to you today? What are 5 things that you can thank God for right now? Write them down and then thank God out loud for those things.

1 Corinthians 1:4

The Bible says to "give thanks in all circumstances." That is hard to do sometimes! But God has given you many things to be thankful for...even when times are tough. Don't focus on the negative. Make a list of your belssinas!

1 Thessalonians 5:18 16

Matthew 6:6
